



Overall, it has been a rather difficult year for our club, our committee is very concerned about the never-ending cost of running Concordia. The hardship of the present economy is biting into the printing, mailing and even the meals at the *RSL*. Everything is constantly changing. To combat our concerns, we need to encourage our members to think about the future of Concordia, not only in your generous donations but also in your general support by getting some of your friends or family involved. I mentioned before that in the latest Australian 2021 Census. We supposed to have around 940 Dutch-Australian citizens in the Newcastle Lake Macquarie regions. Everyone must know some of those families, please mention our Dutch Society Concordia when the opportunity arises or better still, give them a gift subscription as part of your friendship. Think about how you, as our members, can put something back into Concordia without too much effort. I know, I keep repeating this every year but it's our only way of having a sustained membership for a much longer period of time.

During the past year, our committee has met on several occasions. We debated the various Concordia issues. I have no issue with others taking our stories as long as they mention the Concordia newsletter. I love to bring a ray of sunshine to as many Dutch people in Australia and beyond. However, the financial part of emailing could become an issue in the near future. The coloured issues had a dramatic effect on the quality of the newsletter, thanks to *Claudio* of *PixPrint* in Wetherill Park, also to *Jan & Monique van Altena* from *"Het Winkeltje"* in Smithfield for looking after them, *thanks so much!*

This my friends is the Secretaries report 2023-2024 It's a reflection of the past **12** months of serving our members. Thanks, must go to all of you here by your attendance. On a personal level I wish you all good health and many happy years of gezellige (*cosy*) get-togethers within our current *Concordia* framework. 




