

## Divers To Inspect Plane Wreckage

Netherlands authorities may employ an experienced diver to examine the wreckage of the Dutch Dakota plane, which plunged in flames into the sea near Pt. Lookout, Stradbroke Island, on February 26, with the loss of six lives.

They were busy yesterday trying to get essential gear and a suitable boat.

Using grappling irons, police and boatmen brought part of the wreckage, an engine inspection plate, to the surface yesterday.

The plane is lying 60ft. down. Visibility yesterday was still difficult because pounding seas had stirred up a large amount of sediment.
