Wreckage From Dakota

BRISBANE, Monday: Wreckage was washed up on South Moreton Point over the weekend and has definitely been established as having belonged to the Dutch Dakota which crashed into the sea off Point Lookout on February 26.

The commanding officer of the 19th Netherlands East Indies Squadron in Brisbane (Major F. van Breeman) identified the wreckage. He said that immediately the wreck was located salvage operations would begin, with the aid of divers and a crane.

No trace of the lost plane had been found when dragging operations ended tonight.
