BRISBANE Wednesday Australian wharf laborers and Dutch soldiers are working side by side at Pinkenba wharf

The soldiers are loading the Dutch freighter Tijbesar, for Batavia, and the watersiders are working two Australian Army small ships—one berthed at the Titbesar's bows and the other at her stern

The Tibesar is under a union "black" ban, and labor to load her has been refused by the Waterside Workers' Federation.
