

HOLLAND ... THE NETHERLANDS ... DUTCH ... DO WE CONFUSE YOU SOMETIMES??

We frequently receive inquiries from intending travellers who think, that Holland and The Netherlands are two different countries On top of that we are known as the 'DUTCH'.....! That might need some clarification:

Our official name is The Netherlands which means ' the low lands'. The name is very appropriate as a large part of Holland is below sea-level, hence our dykes to keep the sea at bay.

Of our 11 Provinces, 2 are called Holland, namely North-Holland and South-Holland. It is the most densely populated area of The Netherlands and together with the Province of Utrecht they form the Western part of our country. However, the word Holland, to a traveller from abroad, stands for the whole country and we have accepted that, but for a couple of Provinces in the North who are not too keen on that name!

The wordt 'DUTCH' can be traced to a mediaeval word 'Diets' which is connected with our Germanic background.

And now for the currency, which also has people wondering sometimes. Holland uses the Dutch Guilder which, for many centuries, was known as the Florin. The abbreviation for Dutch Florin: DFL. is still used, for instance DFL.100.-, we speak, however, of guilders.






