





It was our first function in the Cardiff RSL Our first get-together for 2024 was perhaps not as busy, but by golly it was a very cosy day for all those attending.











## Stay healthy and up to date this winter

Influenza (flu) is a highly contagious respiratory illness caused by influenza viruses. There are two main types of human influenza viruses:

A and B. There are also many sub-types and strains. Flu is more serious than the common cold and severe cases can result in breathing difficulties and pneumonia. People in NSW can die from flu-related illness. Flu can occur throughout the year but is most common in autumn and winter. In most flu seasons there is more than one strain circulating in the community.

- ◆ Follow these simple steps to reduce the risk of getting sick this winter.
- Wash your hands regularly to reduce infection.
- When you cough and sneeze, cover your nose and mouth with a tissue.
- Go to your doctor if you are sick, save the emergency department for emergencies.
- Get a flu shot.
- Stay at home and keep away from crowded places if you have the flu.
- If you smoke, the best thing you can do for your health is quit. Call the NSW Health Quit line on 131 848.
- In Emergency Departments, emergencies always get priority.
   Remember, minor illness or injuries may be treated by your local doctor.



**Keukenhof** also known as the **Garden of Europe**, is one of the world's largest flower gardens, situated in the municipality of **Lisse** in the Netherlands. Keukenhof is celebrating its **75th anniversary in 2024**.

According to the official website, Keukenhof Park covers an area of 32 hectares (79 acres) and approximately 7 million flower bulbs are planted in the gardens annually. While it is widely known for its tulips, Keukenhof also features numerous other flowers, including;

Hyacinths, daffodils, lilies, roses, carnations and irises.

**Though** its grounds are open year-round for private affairs and festivals, Keukenhof is only open to the general public for a world-renowned eight week tulip display from mid-March to mid-May, with peak viewing arriving near mid-April. Every year the flower park is dedicated to a specific theme. The inspiration gardens, events and artworks are adjusted accordingly.

Je kunt een andere nationaliteit aannemen en niet de Nederlandse nationaliteit verliezen als:

- je geboren bent in het land van jouw andere nationaliteit én je daar woont op het moment dat je die andere nationaliteit aanneemt.
- je voor je achttiende jaar vijf jaar achter elkaar in het land van jouw andere nationaliteit hebt gewoond.
- je getrouwd bent of een erkend geregistreerd hebt met iemand die de andere nationaliteit heeft.

Per land kunnen uitzonderingen gelden, want je hebt zowel met de regels en wetten van Nederland als die van het andere land te maken. Zo gelden bovenstaande uitzonderingen niet voor Nederlanders in Oostenrijk Neem je de Oostenrijkse nationaliteit aan, dan verlies je in ieder geval de Nederlandse nationaliteit. Het is daarom aan te raden om jouw specifieke situatie altijd voor te leggen aan de medewerkers van de Nederlandse ambassade in jouw land. Editor

**Joop**, Thanks for putting in that lovely **100th** Birthday article in the Concordia newsletter (*March-April issue*) All in the family thought it was wonderful. Thanks, *Karl Vanderlely* 

Hi Joop, It was so disappointing to read in the March-April Newsletter your opinion piece on Australia Day 2024, stating "Let's be realistic, Aborigines don't OWN the land." I respect your point of view, but sorry, my friend, that statement is incorrect, for two reasons:

- (1) <u>Historical</u>: For some 65,000 years this continent we now call Australia was occupied solely by First Nations people, it was their land, it was Aboriginal land, there is no doubt they owned it, unchallenged. That all changed on 26 January 1788 when the armed forces of Imperial Great Britain invaded at Sydney to establish a colony. They declared the land was empty, claimed ownership of the land in the name of the King of Great Britain, and started killing any Aboriginal people who resisted being forced off their lands. Unlike all other colonies of European powers there was no treaty here with the First Nations people.
- (2) <u>Legal:</u> In 1992 the High Court of Australia in the Mabo case found that Native Title existed, that is, that First Nations people living on their traditional lands had title to that land, they owned it. The Federal Government legislated to give legal effect to the Court's decision. Aboriginal ownership of land is now recognised in Australian law.

The controversy about Australia Day is no surprise because the date marks the British invasion, the big theft of land and the start of massacres of Aboriginal people. Celebrating such injustice is not a good way to promote the unity, peace and harmony we seek in our country. *John Wills.*
