28/6/43

This morning lascar Samanuddin being on the job of painting the funnel, fell from top of funnel on deck and was badly hurt. He was at once taken to Hospital. Apparently the chain runner was not properly made fast because it slipped from the boatswain chair in which he was sitting.

Brisbane

4/7/43

Today a message was received from the General Hospital stating the lascar Samanuddin is suffering from a fractured spine and a fractured ankle, that he will probable be an inmate of the hospital for three weeks and that he is considered to be unfit for duty at sea for a period of twelve months.

Brisbane

15/7/43

Today a message was received stating that lascar Samanuddin suddenly died in the General Hospital on the 14th of July at 7 p.m."

Messrs.Java Bengal Line, Calcutta further advised us of payment of compensation to the widow of Lascar Abdul Malik ex s.s."Sembilangan".

We quote below their letter of the 20th February 1945 in this connection and the relative copy of Court Order :

" Lascar Abdul Malik ex s.s. "Sembilangan"

The above mentioned seaman's widow, Noor Bannu filed a claim against us in the Court of the Commissioner for Workmen's Compensation, Bengal, for the loss of her husband's life on the 29.5.42.
