

QANTAS CUTTING BRISBANE STAFF

The transfer of Dutch military and civilian air headquarters to Batavia has meant a further reduction of staff at Qantas Airways' servicing and repair depot for aircraft engines at Moorooka.

The company is dismissing some men employed on a temporary basis during the period of unsettled conditions since the end of the war.

The depot, established as a war time measure, at one time employed several hundred men.
